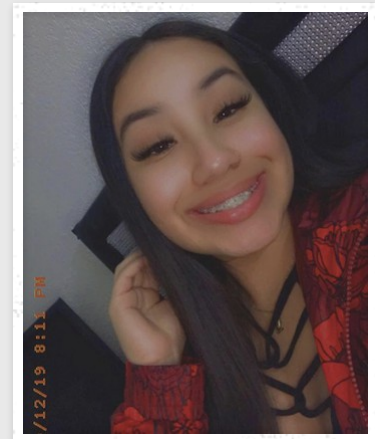

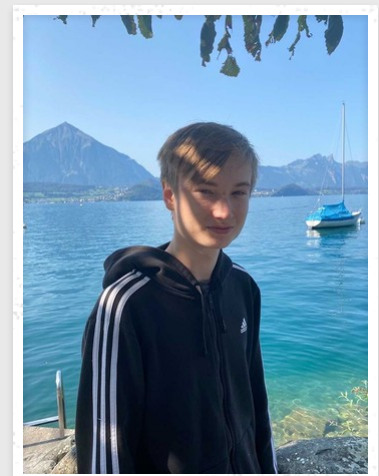
SCHOOL SITE COUNCIL SELECTIONS

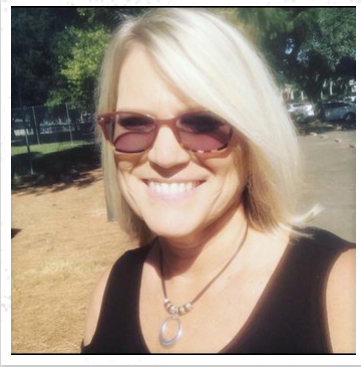

MEET NEW HPH FACULTY



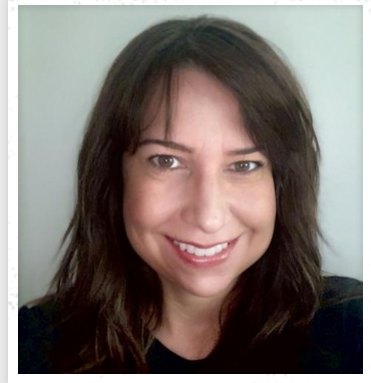
MEET MS. VAUGHN

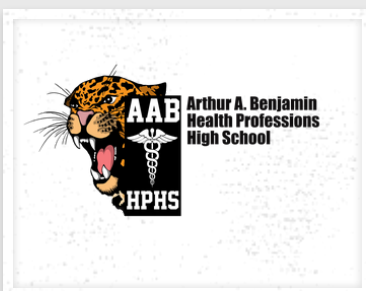
